1. House White, Puglia £17.95

An outstanding house white, a fruity and fragrant blend of Sauvignon and Malvasia made by the European Winery of the year, Cantine San Marzano.

2. Zibibbo 'Vitesse', Colomba Bianca Sicilia £19.95

Bright and perfumed with notes of Orange blossom, jasmine and citrus fruits.

3. Pignoletto Frizzante, Gruppo Cevico, Emilia Romagna £20.95

An increasingly popular wine, vibrant fresh fruit with an enticing gentle fizz, almost like a cross between Pinot Grigio and Prosecco.

4. Vernaccia di San Gimignano DOCG, Bonacchi, Tuscano £20.95

Delicate penetrating aromas of lemony fruit, with some light floral notes. A dry and fresh tasting wine with a slightly nutty finish.

5. Albente Falanghina, Feudi di San Gregorio, Campania £21.95

Clean and fresh nose, with stone-fruit and melon flavours, brilliant with seafood linguine.

6. Pinot Grigio IGT Collevento Antonutti, Veneto £22.95

Good intensity, fresh tasting with good persistence.

7. Verdicchio dei Castelli dei Jesi Doc, Marche £23.95

Fresh and persistent aromas, well balanced freshness and sapidity. Dry elegant and easy drinking.

8. Orvieto DOC Amabile Tenuta Le Velette, Umbria £24.95

Lightly sweet, soft and balanced with a pleasantly fragrant aroma. Fresh and flowery.

9. Vermentino DOC Sella & Mosca, Sardegna £25.95

100% Vermentino. Light straw yellow in colour, very intense. Enhancing fruit that lingers on the soft leisurely finish.

10. Alcamo Bianco DOC Firriato, Sicilia £26.50

Blend of Cataratto and Inzolia. Golden Yellow, elegantly scented. Palate is fresh with a gentle balancing acidity

11. Gavi Di Gavi 'Fossili' San Silvestro, Piemonte £26.95

100% Cortese. Slightly spicy fruit with a pleasant mineral tone and a crisp fresh finish.

Alto Adige

Rich, full and dry with notes of ripe melon, and good mineral character layered with a hint of almond and a long persistent finish.

13. Sauvignon DOC Poggiobello Friuli £28.50

Straw yellow with green tinges. Refreshing and light aromas, dry and velvety finish.

14. Fiano Sophia Bianco, Basilisco £28.50
Basiliscata

Wonderful Fiano with delicate aromas of fresh flowers, roses and yellow peaches. The palate is refreshing and crisp with a luscious texture, and aromatic finish.

15. Yamada Pecorino IGT Zaccagnini, Abruzzo £33.00

Citrus aromatic bouquet with grapefruit very evident, fresh and lingering taste.

Colomba Bianca, Sicilia

Pronounced cherry and strawberry aromas combined with an elegant hint of rosewater.

17. Pinot Grigio Blush IGT, Veneto £18.95

Pale pink colour. A delicate fruity fragrance and crisp apple flavours with a hint of almond.

18. Primitivo rose Salento 'Tramari' £23.00
San Marzano, Puglia

Pale and tangy rose with aromas of strawberries and roses, with a creamy background and gentle spice.

19. House Red-Negroamaro, Puglia £17.95

Fantastic value red, made by Cantine San Marzano the multi-award winning winery, dark red fruits with a rounded rich finish.

20. House Montepulciano, Abruzzo £18.95

Great value, full bodied with smooth tannins producing a great match to pasta and meat

21. Nero D'Avola 'Vitesse', Colomba Bianca Sicilia £19.95

Juicy flavours of fleshy plum and black cherries, interlaced with subtle sweet spice and liquorice.

22. Merlot DOC, Zonin, Friuli £20.95

The aroma is pleasantly full and intense the flavour is properly dry and expressed with agreeable equilibrium and harmony.

23. Lambrusco Secco 'Favortia' Medici Ermete, Emilia Romagna £20.95

Full-flavoured semi-sparkling dry and fleshy wine, with fresh raspberries and blackcurrant fruit.

24. Sangiovese 'Diavoli' Gruppo Cevico, Emilia Romagna £21.95

Deep red with purplish edges, a charming bouquet with characteristic flavours of dried flowers and red fruit.

25. Chianti Classico 'Black Rooster' Bonacchi, Tuscany £23.95

Deep ruby colour, with aromas of cherry and violet. Well-balanced.

26. Chianti Classico, Zonin, Toscano £28.00

Dry full properly balanced and extremely enticing with lingering acidity and flavours of cherry and spice

27. Brindisi Rosso DOC Cantina Due Palme, Puglia £23.95

Super ripe fruit on the nose. Palate is packed with dark fruit flavours. Full-bodied and smooth.

28. Valpolicella Rio Alba, Ca'rugate, Veneto £24.95

Ruby red with a bouquet of blackberry and cherries. A supple palate with light tannins and plenty of flavour.

29. Ripa Delle Mandorle, Castello Vicchiomaggio, Toscano £24.95

Graceful and complex with aromas of berries, spice and violets. Made by an English man, John Matta, who has been voted four times as IWSC Italian winemaker of the year.

30. Montepulciano D'Abruzzo Zaccagnini, Abruzzo £26.95

Ruby red colour, dry and full-bodied. Full, soft black cherry flavours and damson fruit aromas.

31. Barbera D'Asti DOC Vespa, Piemonte £28.95

Intense ruby red, dry and medium bodied.

32. Primitivo di Manduria, Cantine San Marzano, Puglia £28.95

Generous bouquet of ripe cherries and plums, with notes of cocoa and vanilla. A warm velvety texture with a lovely sweet finish.

33. Isola del Nuraghi IGT Cagnulari, Parpinello, Sardinia £29.95

A full bodied dry red wine showing notes of mature red fruits and Spice on the palate. Flavoursome with a soft texture and tannins.

34. Chiramonte Nero D'Avola IGT Firriato, Sicilia £31.50

A rush of black fruit and spices on the nose. Extraordinarily round and complete.

35. Pinot Nero DOC Tramin, Alto Adige £33.00

Summer fruit aromas, with mountain herbs and a touch of oak. Delicate and fine-classic Pinot Noir.

36. Aglianico Irpinia, Feudi Di San Gregorio, Campania £33.00

Wild black fruit and liquorice aromas. Well-balanced with juicy black fruit and spicy notes, soft well-structured tannins.

37. Valpolicello Superiore 'Ripasso' DOC Ca'rugate, Veneto £35.50

Intense garnet colour, concentrated aromas of cherry, with a hint of spice and flowers. Full-bodied with soft velvety tannins.

38. Santagostino Rosso IGT Firriato, Sicilia £36.50

Blend of Nero D'Avola and Syrah. Barrique aged, notes of mature red fruits and spices.

39. Nebbiolo d'Alba 'Il Principe' Michele Chiarlo, Piemonte £39.95

Noble wine of excellent character from Langhe, typical fruit characteristics, refined and elegant.

40. Vino Nobile Di Montepulciano Riserva, Carpineto, Toscano £44.00

Mature flavours with earthy and dark liquorice tones and hints of fresh prunes; smooth palate with lovely weight and a long finish.
